Class Credits

Classes offered through the Emory Law Summer in Budapest Program are graded and each class earns 1-2 credit hours. Law students have a six credit limit on Summer in Budapest coursework that can be applied toward graduation requirements. If you attend another law school, you will need to ask if credits earned through the Emory Law Summer in Budapest Program will apply toward your graduation requirements.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

If the Summer Program in Budapest is cancelled by Emory University and/or Central European University, students will be issued a full refund of their tuition. All students are required to submit a \$100 non-refundable application fee. Students must pay a partially refundable deposit of \$1,000 due six weeks before the program begins.

For cancellations by students, the refund policy for the \$1,000 deposit is as follows:

- If the student cancels within four weeks of the first day of class, the student will receive a full refund.

Students who fail to appear at Central European University for classes or who drop once the courses have begun will not receive a refund.
