- 1) Transient students may register only for courses that are not filled by degree candidates. Although course selection is rarely a problem, some courses occasionally close during the fall and spring semesters. Transient students are urged to select alternative courses in advance to guard against being foreclosed from registering for a sufficient number of hours.
- 2) Transient students who attend Emory during the fall and spring semesters may register only in those courses that are approved by the degree-granting institution, and in accordance with Emory's course load limitations and prerequisite requirements.
- 3) Enrollment as a transient student precludes an individual from acceptance at a later date as a degree candidate. A student who is accepted as a transient student but who does not enroll as such is not entitled to acceptance as a degree candidate at a later date; subsequent application for admission as a degree candidate must be made pursuant to the normal procedures and deadlines set forth in the catalog. Special consideration is not afforded such candidates.
- 4) Any student registering in any division of Emory University is required to have the appropriate medical history form completed and sent to the Emory University Student Health Service. The medical history form is sent to the student with the acceptance letter, and must be returned prior to registration.
- 5) Transient students are subject to all rules, regulations, practices, and policies of Emory University.
